Dear Parents,

The Department has now issued guidance on schools re-opening arrangements, the start of the new school year will begin on Monday 24th August 2020 for Primary 7 children. The current DE guidance of pupils returning to a classroom is at a distance of 1 metre apart and staff at a distance of 2 metres.

Taking these regulations into consideration, our year groupings and accommodation facilities, we as a staff and in consultation with our Board of Governors are working on the premise of having all children phased back into school from the same week beginning Monday 24th August.

This will be an induction week which will help our pupils settle back into the new school day and adapted environment. We will focus on some Literacy, Numeracy, Health and Well Being activities with the children to ensure they make a smooth transition back to school.

Our proposed plan for our Induction Week on Monday 24th- Friday 28th August is as follows:

For this initial week, with the exception of Primary 7 pupils who will be in school for the full day 8.35am – 2.35 pm, all other year groups will be in school for morning sessions only 8.35am – 12 noon with children returning home for lunch. Pupils are requested to wear their school PE Uniform for this Induction Week.

Our Induction Week will enable staff to evaluate and review new school routines and safety practices. We hope that a normal school day will be available for all year groupings including Reception from Tuesday 1st September from 8.35am – 2.35 pm. Pupils are requested to wear their full school Uniform as normal. School will be closed on Monday 31st August as it is a Bank Holiday. There will be no Rec-P2 Afterschool until further notice.

Please be aware that these re-opening arrangements are subject to change in light of evolving DE Guidance.
