Dear Parents,

I hope you have had a peaceful Christmas and on behalf of all staff and governors I would like to wish all our families a safe and healthy New Year.

I would like to take this opportunity to very much thank all our parents, families and members of our school community who supported our Christmas Raffle, we raised an outstanding amount of £1124.00. I would like to pay tribute to our pupils who worked extremely hard to sell tickets and I would also very much like to thank the members of the "Friends of St. Teresa's" who helped prepare the fabulous Christmas Hampers.

The amount raised is a testament of our school family's commitment, dedication and generosity to St. Teresa's Primary School, Tullyherron.

We plan to purchase new Outside Play Equipment which will be used by all our pupils in the Foundation Class, KS1 and KS2 classes.

Unfortunately, as we begin this new School Term, Coronavirus and particularly Omicron is widespread, so it is very important that we rigorously implement our COVID protocols. Please remember to social distance and wear a face covering in the school grounds. If your child(ren) is/are displaying any Coronavirus symptoms, please keep your child(ren) off school and complete a lateral flow test. If they test positive you will have to follow PHA guidance and contact the school. If they test negative, they can return to school as long as they are not displaying any COVID symptoms (high temperature, continuous cough and loss of sense of taste or smell).

If a close contact of your child(ren) i.e. someone who lives with them tests positive for COVID you must keep your child(ren) off school and complete a lateral flow test. They can return to school if they test negative, have no COVID symptoms and continue to complete lateral flow tests daily for ten days. If they test positive on a lateral flow test, they will have to isolate. Children under 5 do not have to take a PCR test unless advised by a doctor but should not attend school if they have COVID symptoms or have tested positive on a lateral flow test. If you are unsure if your child(ren) should attend school, please contact Mrs Mc Court and she will advise on the actions you should follow but children should not be coming to school if they are feeling unwell. Remember that if your child(ren) test(s) positive for COVID they may have to isolate for 10 days however if they have two negative lateral flow test results on days six and seven and have no COVID symptoms they may return to school. It is very important that parents contact the school before their child(ren) return to school to confirm that they have followed PHA guidance.

Class teachers will arrange work for child(ren) which can be collected from school if appropriate i.e. literacy and Numeracy activities and Reading Book(s) while they are isolating. I would like to thank all families who have already followed the guidelines and thank everyone for your anticipated cooperation during the next few weeks/months which could be very challenging for us all. It is imperative that we all work together to protect ourselves and others. Thank you.
