#### **Cycling Proficiency Scheme**

We are inviting our Primary 6 and 7 pupils to participate in the Cycling Proficiency Scheme in Term 3. Cycling is a fun and great way to get around and stay fit but it is important that children are trained to cycle safely and have an understanding of the associated road safety issues. The Cycling Proficiency Scheme's aim is to teach children how to ride their bicycles safely and learn important road safety skills. The Scheme is a combination of practical and theoretical aspects and pupil competence is measured through a final test in June. The Scheme will be led by Mr Mc Cann each Monday from 1.30pm to 2.30pm, on the school grounds, beginning on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April and finishing on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June. All pupils participating need to bring their bicycles and helmets into school each Monday, the first lesson will involve a "Bicycle Safety Check", which will involve checking Brakes, Tyres, Bells etc.
